Lancaster County Impaired Streams

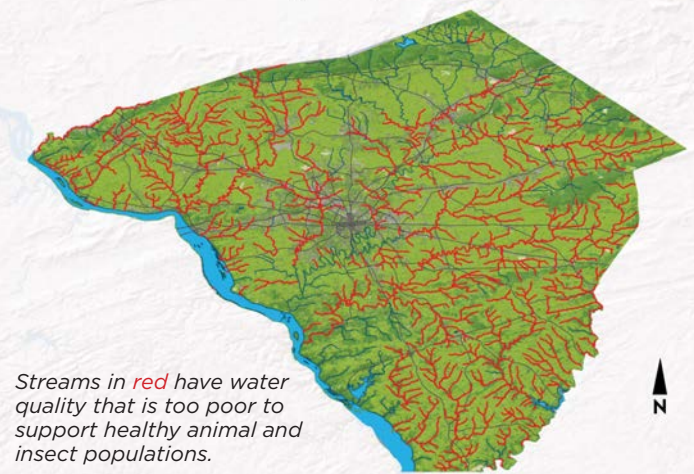
